DIRECTOR'S NOTE

It has been my absolute privilege to work with this incredible group of students. I have worked as a parent volunteer in theater since moving here in 2019, and years ago when I was a high school English teacher, I ran a theater program. But it has been many years since I have sat in the director's chair! Admittedly, I was a little apprehensive, but it turns out that it was just like riding a bike - it came right back, and it has been an absolute delight. The joy in directing is watching the cast as they grow into their roles, and this is an incredible group of students. I was a bit intimidated by the show Into the Woods, not having had much experience with it personally, but as I read about the show, watched interviews with James Lapine and Stephen Sondheim, and learned its history, I felt excited. There is much more to this show than the entertainment it will undoubtedly provide. This is a story of and for our time. A story of individuals, all desperate for something, a way to improve their own individual circumstances, unfolds in the first act, with many of the wishes coming true. But as many of us learn when we can't find contentment in our circumstances, the acquisition of their wishes comes at a great cost. In Act 2, the players discover an outside evil is wreaking havoc in their land, and during a poignant second act full of loss, they discover that no one is alone and that they are truly stronger as a community, united in a single wish.

I am so thankful for the amazing talents of our music director, Kara Degenhardt and her partnership on this show! Finally, there would be absolutely no show at all without the tremendous talents, time, and commitment of our parent volunteers. 
